Requirements for Undergraduate Oboe Audition

I. Live Audition

A. General Music or Music Education Major

- 1. Knowledge of all major and minor scales two octaves to high F.
- 2. Two contrasting movements from a standard sonata or concerto of your choice.
- 3. One Barret or Ferling étude.
- 4. Sight-reading may be required.

B. Oboe performance major

- 1. Knowledge of all major and minor scales two octaves to high F.
- 2. Two contrasting movements from a standard sonata or concerto of your choice.
- 3. One complete Barret étude or fast Ferling étude.
- 4. Sight-reading may be required.

II. Taped Audition

A. General Music or Music Education Major

- 1. Please record the scales of D major and B harmonic minor. Play the scales two octaves, legato, starting softly at the bottom with a crescendo to the top and a diminuendo on the way down.
- 2. Two contrasting movements from a standard sonata or concerto of your choice.
- 3. One Barret or Ferling étude.

B. Oboe performance major

- 1. Please record the scales of E major and C# harmonic minor. Play the scales two octaves, legato, staring softly at the bottom with a crescendo to the top and a diminuendo on the way down.
- 2. Two contrasting movements from a standard sonata or concerto of your choice.
- 3. One complete Barret étude (from Grande Études) or fast Ferling étude (from 48 Famous Études).

2nd year transfer applicants: One work from the standard repertoire. Scales and arpeggios (major, minor, chromatic and whole tone) and sight-reading may be required.

3rd year transfer applicants: Two contrasting works from the standard repertoire. Scales and arpeggios (major, minor, chromatic and whole tone) and sight-reading may be required.
